Series Synopsis *(Based on the award-winning trilogy by Marcha Fox & Pete Risingsun)*

When Air Force veteran **Bryan Reynolds** dies in a suspicious accident in Colorado's Dead Horse Canyon, his final words — *"Don't let them get away with this!"* — become a call to action for the two people who loved him most.

His widow, **Sara Reynolds**, survives the crash but awakens to a nightmare: Bryan is dead, she remembers nothing of his plea's context, and powerful forces are watching her every move. Grief transforms her from an obscure physical therapist into a relentless truth-seeker determined to discover what Bryan found so she can fulfill his dying plea, despite warnings from her father, a former FBI analyst, that she's risking her life.

Bryan's best friend, **Charlie Littlewolf**, a Cheyenne tribal member haunted by his past, senses something dark at play. Raised by a grandfather who foresaw Charlie's role in fulfilling ancient seventh-generation prophecies, as a teen Charlie rejected his Indigenous heritage. Now, driven by loyalty and guilt, he's forced to reconnect with traditions he abandoned — and powers he never fully understood that could deliver long-awaited retribution for his people.

Bryan's hacking revealed a Top-Secret project embroiled in a convoluted web of corporate and government collusion buried deep beneath the Rocky Mountains: a taxpayer-funded sanctuary designed to protect lobbyists and elites during an apocalypse. Exposure would boost support for a Constitutional amendment on the ballot to permanently end corporate lobbying.

Sara and Charlie become targets of **Bernard Keller's private security force**, whose mission shifts from simple site security to surveillance when they realize the pair's intent. As scrutiny tightens and violence escalates, cryptic messages — both digital and spiritual — guide Sara and Charlie toward answers as well as the final surviving copy of the data.

When anonymous channels fail, Sara releases the truth publicly, igniting national outrage — and provoking strong retaliation as she's seen as a symbol of effective citizen resistance. A shadow nonprofit places a million-dollar bounty on her head, of which she's entirely unaware.

Across three seasons, Bryan's legacy sees Sara evolve from grieving widow to activist icon while fighting assassin-induced disabilities while Charlie pursues an equally treacherous journey toward spiritual awakening and prophetic destiny. Their paths converge as an ancient curse collides with modern corruption, leading to healing, reckoning, and long-delayed justice — not just for Bryan, but for generations silenced before him.
